

TOPS

- Appropriate shirt styles: polos, t-shirts, button up shirts, or blouses. Shirts may be long or short sleeves and solid or patterned.
- Inappropriate shirt styles: halters, keyholes, cold shoulders, holes, strapless, spaghetti straps, open armed shirts, tank tops, or shirts that the underarm or midriff is exposed when arms are raised.

BOTTOMS

- Appropriate pant styles: pants, jeans, capris, skirts, skorts, shorts, or boys' style basketball shorts. Bottoms may be solid or patterned. They must be worn properly at the waist. Undergarments cannot show. Pockets must lay flat against the fabric. No more than 6 pockets are allowed. All bottoms must be hemmed and must not touch/drag on the ground. No holes are allowed.
- Dresses: May be long or short sleeves and solid or patterned. Dresses must be hemmed and must not touch/drag on the ground.
- Inappropriate dress styles: halters, keyholes, cold shoulders, holes, strapless, spaghetti straps, open armed, tank tops, or dresses that the underarm or midriff is exposed when arms are raised.
- Dresses, skirts, skorts, or shorts must not be shorter than 5 inches above the knee.
- Inappropriate materials/styles: no holes, spandex, leather, suede, vinyl, overalls, coveralls, wind pants, athletic jogging pants, yoga pants, sweat pants, PE uniforms, leggings, jeggings, or athletic shorts are allowed.

OUTERWEAR

- Appropriate outerwear: sweaters, vests, and sweatshirts. The hood cannot be worn on the head during school hours or at extra-curricular activities. Outerwear may be solid or patterned.
- All Coats and jackets must be stored in the locker BEFORE arrival to advisory or mini course. Coats and jackets will remain in the locker until dismissal. Coats and jackets may not be worn in any way that reflects gang affiliation, conceals contraband or creates a distraction.

FOOTWEAR

- Shoes must be comfortable for walking.
- All shoes must have a back or heel strap which must be worn appropriately. Shoes must be secured to the feet.
- Heels may not be higher than 2 inches.
- Inappropriate footwear: flip flops, house slippers, athletic sandals, shower shoes, roller shoes, or any shoes deemed inappropriate are not allowed.

HAIR, JEWELRY, AND ACCESSORIES

- Pierced jewelry is only allowed in the ears.
- Leather, spiked, chains, and sharp edges are not allowed.
- Inappropriate language, symbols, and graphics on garments, shoes, jewelry, and/or accessories are not allowed.
- Hats, bandanas, sweatbands, hoods, and head gear (including floral crowns and animal ears) are not allowed.
- Blankets, pillows, slippers, stuffed animals, balloons, and toys are not allowed.
- Unnatural hair color and distracting hair styles that disrupt the learning environment are not allowed.
- Sunglasses are not allowed to be worn inside the school.

BADGES, BAGS, AND BACKPACKS

- Due to safety, badges must be unaltered, worn, and visible at all times around the neck or clipped to the collar of a garment.
- Due to safety and classroom size, all types of backpacks, tote bags, book bags, etc. must be stored in the locker BEFORE arrival to advisory/mini course and remain there until dismissal. Lockers may be accessed before first period, between all classes, and after school. Students are allowed to carry a string bag during the school day.

DRESS CODE ENFORCEMENT

- Any clothing, shoes, accessory, hair color, or hairstyle that is deemed inappropriate will result in the student being required to change or adjust prior to attending classes. Repeated failure to comply will result in disciplinary action.
